THE SLIGHT EDGE

Having the slight edge puts me a little ahead of everyone else

The difference is not my ability or intellegence but my application.

Work to be a little more creative and a little better trained.

The slight edge is dependant on my focus, attention, and willing-

- I must be an early riser. What I do the night before affects my next morning. Spend time in Word, set focus, set objectives for the day, time in prayer.
- 2) I must learn to have good posture. Walk tall!!
- I must learn to be a lady. Benefits in any situation. My life is limited otherwise. Help people feel at ease.
- I must walk 25% faster. I will have 25% more time and will look like I know where I'm going.
- 5) I must refuse to be mediocre or average. "When you ask little of life, life will pay your price." GO FOR IT AND WORK HARD!!
- 6) I must stop T.V. mentality. Don't waste time, learn to create and not entertained.

- 11) I must keep a life notebook. Concerns between God and I, learn to write neatly.
- 12) I must put God's word in my life daily. Use my mind when I'm doing something that I don't need to think. (Shower, riding in car, hoeing, etc.)
- 13) I must learn to keep physically fit. When I feel better I can think better. Exercise is important but not dominant.
- 14) I must look sharp. Look my best, never grubby, colors coordinate, dress for the occassion.
- 15) I must be on job (OR school) early and leave late. Shows eagerness to work. Early is on time. Some of us have trained ourselves to be late.
