

5-Day Devotional

A Life that Reveals God

Monday: You Were Given

Scripture: John 17:6

“They were Yours... You gave them to Me.”

Reflection:

You are not random. Not overlooked. Not an accident.

Before you ever pursued God—the Father gave you to Jesus.

That means your life carries intention and value. You are not trying to find purpose—you were created with it.

Prayer:

Father, thank You for choosing me and giving me to Jesus. Help me live today with that confidence.

Application:

Start your day by declaring: *I am given. My life has purpose.*

Tuesday: Given With Purpose

Scripture: John 17:6

Reflection:

Every gift has a purpose.

Jesus said, “I have revealed You...” —His mission was to make the Father known. And now your life is meant to reflect Him.

This is not about striving—it’s about living aligned.

Prayer:

Jesus, reveal the Father to me more clearly so I can reflect Him to others.

Application:

What is one area where God is asking you to align your life with His truth?

Wednesday: In the World, Not of It

Scripture: John 17:14–15

Reflection:

The *kosmos*—the world—constantly pressures us to perform and conform. It tells us who to be, how to act, and what to value. But Jesus reminds us: you are in the world, but not of it. You don't have to play a role—you already have an identity.

Prayer:

Lord, help me resist the pressure to conform and remain rooted in who You say I am.

Application:

Where is the world shaping your thinking, behavior, or priorities?

Thursday: Sent Into the World

Scripture: John 17:18

Reflection:

You are not just saved—you are sent. God has placed you exactly where you are for a reason. Your workplace, your family, your relationships—these are not random. They are part of your mission field.

Prayer:

Lord, open my eyes to where You have sent me. Help me live on purpose today.

Application:

Who is one person you can intentionally show God's love to today?

Friday: You Carry His Glory

Scripture: John 17:22

Reflection:

Jesus said, "The glory You gave Me, I have given them." You don't have to chase significance—you carry it. God's presence is revealed through your love, your unity, and your choices.

Prayer:

Holy Spirit, let Your glory be revealed through my life today.

Application:

What would it look like for you to *reveal* God's presence in one situation today?
