
#### God is on the Move at COV!

#### "New Life. New Community. New Commitment."

Discovering the power of God in you and the people around you.

#### **Monday: Activated by Grace**



"I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him."

#### **Reflection:**

You were divinely designed with purpose before birth. But it is faith in Jesus that activates the fullness of that design—like pulling the tab on a scale, what was already built in comes alive. Paul reminds us that God's *power* is already working *in* us who believe. Your conversion wasn't just a moment—it was an activation.

## A Prayer Prompt:

Ask God to help you see the areas in your life where His power is waiting to be activated by faith.

## **7** Today's Challenge:

Write down one way your life changed after trusting in Jesus. Share it with someone or journal about how that moment continues to shape you.

# Tuesday: Christ in You — The Secret Revealed

**□** *Colossians 1:26–27* 

"And this is the secret: Christ lives in you. This gives you assurance of sharing his glory."

## **Reflection:**

Paul describes a mystery hidden for generations—now revealed: *Christ lives in you*. This changes how we live in every space—home, work, and church. Your calm in chaos, your peace in storms, your hope in suffering—these testify to Christ in you. It's not a secret to hide, but a presence to reveal.


# 🙏 Prayer Prompt:

Ask Jesus to give you the boldness to live out His peace and power in visible, tangible ways.

## **∳** Today's Challenge:

When faced with stress or uncertainty today, pause and say out loud: "Christ lives in me." Let that truth anchor you.

## Wednesday: Called into Community



"Lead a life worthy of your calling... making allowance for each other's faults because of your love."

#### Reflection:

New life in Christ leads to a *new community* in Christ. God didn't call us to follow Jesus alone. The early church left behind not just old habits but old communities and allegiances. Paul calls us to a higher kind of love: humble, patient, and united. Unity doesn't mean we all think alike—but we love alike.

## **A** Prayer Prompt:

Invite God to help you love those in your church community—even those who challenge you.

#### **♦** Today's Challenge:

Text or call someone from your faith community and encourage them. Be a bridge of grace today.

## Thursday: Every Person Has a Role

**Ephesians 4:11–13** 

"Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church..."

## Reflection:

No one is sidelined in the Kingdom of God. If Christ is in you, then His calling is *on* you. God designed community so we could build one another up. Pastors and teachers equip—but *every believer* is called to serve. Maturity and unity come as we engage together in God's mission.

## A Prayer Prompt:

Ask God to show you your role in building His church. Pray for humility and courage to serve.

## **7** Today's Challenge:

Ask a church leader how you can help—or look for a need and quietly meet it.

## Friday: Equipped for Battle

**Ephesians 6:10–13** 

"Put on all of God's armor... then after the battle you will still be standing firm."

## Reflection:

Spiritual life brings spiritual warfare. New life invites resistance. While the community supports us, each person must *personally* put on God's armor. You are not defenseless. God's armor—truth, righteousness, faith, salvation, the Word—is yours. The promise? You *will still be standing*.

# A Prayer Prompt:

Ask the Holy Spirit to dress you today in God's full armor. Declare your dependence on His strength.

# **≯** Today's Challenge:

Choose one piece of God's armor and memorize a Scripture related to it. Use it in prayer throughout your day.
