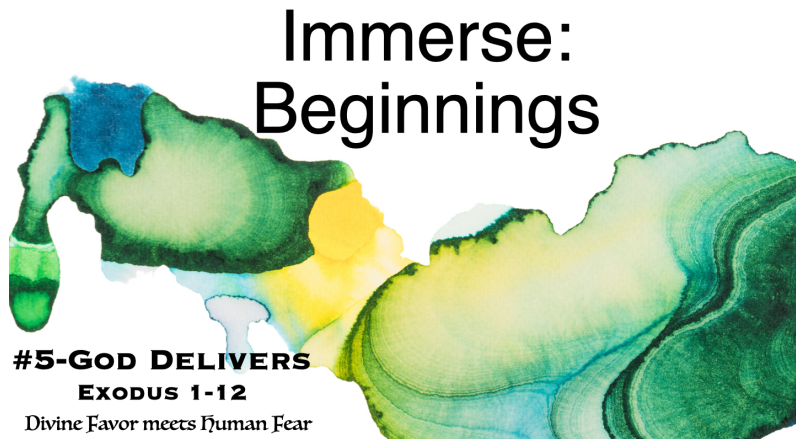


God Delivers

A 5-day companion to Exodus 1-13



Monday — When Favor Feels Like a Fight

📖 *Read: Exodus 1:6–14;*

John 15:18–19

God's favor on the Israelites brought unexpected opposition. Pharaoh feared their growth and strength. Yet the same God who blessed them was fully aware of their suffering.

Favor doesn't mean freedom from conflict—it means God is at work *in* the conflict.

☁️ **Reflect:**

- Has God's favor ever brought unexpected resistance in your life?
- What might God be revealing about Himself through your current challenge?

🙏 **Pray:**

"Lord, help me see opposition not as rejection, but as the soil where Your power grows."

Tuesday — Oppression and God's Presence

📖 *Read: Exodus 3:1–10; Exodus 6:2–3*

Moses encountered God in the wilderness—an ordinary place made holy by God's presence.

Through oppression, God moved His people from hearing promises to experiencing His presence.

☁️ **Reflect:**

- Where has God turned an ordinary moment into holy ground for you?
- How might your own hardship become a meeting place with God?

🙏 **Pray:**

"God of Abraham and Moses, help me recognize Your presence even in pressure and pain."

Wednesday — The Fight Ends Where God's Presence Begins

 Read: Exodus 6:6–9; Philippians 4:6–7

God promised Israel freedom, redemption, and relationship—but discouragement blinded them.

Faith doesn't always remove fear, but God's presence disarms it.

 **Reflect:**

- What discouragement tempts you to stop listening to God's promises?
- How can you invite His peace to guard your heart today?

 **Pray:**

"Lord, when I grow weary, remind me that Your presence is my deliverance."

Thursday — Promise, Presence, Personal

 Read: Genesis 15:13–14; Exodus 12:36; John 14:16–17

God's relationship with His people has always moved closer—
from *promise* in Genesis,
to *presence* in Exodus,
to *personal indwelling* in the New Testament.

Through the Holy Spirit, we now have continual communion with Him.

 **Reflect:**

- Do you live as though God is distant or dwelling within you?
- What changes when you remember the Spirit of God lives in you?

 **Pray:**

"Holy Spirit, make me aware of Your presence within me—moment by moment."

Friday — God Delivers to Dwell Among Us

 Read: Exodus 29:45–46; John 1:14; Revelation 21:3

God's purpose has never been just to rescue—it's to *reside*.

From the tabernacle to the cross to the indwelling Spirit, His desire remains the same:
to dwell with His people.

 **Reflect:**

- Where do you sense God inviting you into deeper relationship today?
- How might your deliverance become someone else's testimony of His faithfulness?

 **Pray:**

"God who delivers, thank You for dwelling with me. Let my life reflect Your presence to others."
