

How Do You See Others?

Day 1 – Image Bearers

Scripture

So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. Genesis 1:27

Every person you encounter bears the image of God.

Before they are a political opponent, difficult neighbor, demanding coworker, or stranger in a crowd, they are someone created by God and loved by Him.

Today ask:

"Who have I reduced to a label instead of seeing as an image bearer?"

Prayer

Father, help me see people through Your eyes rather than through my assumptions.

Day 2 – The Heart Behind Religion

Scripture

"This is what the Lord of Heaven's Armies says: Judge fairly, and show mercy and kindness to one another. 10 Do not oppress widows, orphans, foreigners, and the poor. And do not scheme against each other. Zechariah 7:9-10

The people asked God about fasting.

God answered with justice, mercy, and compassion.

Why?

Because spiritual maturity is measured not merely by religious activity but by transformed relationships.

Prayer

Lord, make my faith visible in how I treat others.

Day 3 – Seeing Potential

Scripture

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. Romans 5:8

Jesus saw more than who people were.

He saw who they could become through grace.

The same is true for you.

The same is true for others.

Prayer

Jesus, help me see people as works in progress rather than finished products.

Day 4 – The Disciple's Lens

Scripture

Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Matthew 28:19

Discipleship is God's process for transformation.

The more we follow Jesus, the more our perspective changes.

Ask yourself:

Who is helping me become more like Christ?

Who am I helping become more like Christ?

Prayer

Lord, continue Your transforming work in me.

Day 5 – Loving Like Jesus

Scripture

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! 2 Corinthians 5:16

Paul says we no longer evaluate people from a human point of view.

That does not happen naturally.

It happens as Christ changes our hearts.

Prayer

Lord, teach me to see people as You see them—people of dignity, value, and worth.
