- Generosity reflecting God's grace
- Reputation of service



Living the Story Together

- Share your story
- Unity in the body
- Culminates in an effective community of believers

Monday – Rooted in God

Scripture: *“Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.”* — Colossians 2:7

Reflection:

Faith isn't static; it grows as we are rooted deeper in Jesus. To be rooted is to allow His Word and Spirit to nourish us daily. Without strong roots, storms shake us easily. With them, we flourish in every season.

Application:

Spend 15 minutes today in Scripture. Write down one truth that anchors your heart and share it with someone.

Prayer:

Lord, deepen my roots in You. Build my life on Your truth so that my faith overflows with thankfulness. Amen.

Tuesday – Equipped through Prayer & Repentance

Scripture: *“God uses it (Scripture) to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.”* — 2 Timothy 3:17

Reflection:

God does not call us to serve in our own strength. He equips us through His Word, and He sharpens us through repentance. Prayer is not an add-on—it is the power source. Repentance is not shame—it is realignment with God's holiness.

Application:

Take time today to pray honestly. Ask God where He wants to realign your heart. Write down one step of obedience.

Prayer:

Father, equip me through Your Word, empower me through prayer, and realign me through repentance. I want to serve You fully prepared. Amen.

Wednesday – Active in Generosity & Service

Scripture: *“In his grace, God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well.”* — Romans 12:6

Reflection:

Serving is not about busyness—it’s about giftedness. God has given each of us spiritual gifts for His glory and the good of others. Generosity is not limited to money; it is the overflow of grace in every area of life.

Application:

Identify one way you can serve or give generously today—whether encouragement, time, resources, or kindness. Act on it.

Prayer:

Lord, activate my faith through the gifts You’ve given me. Help me to serve generously and joyfully so others may see Your grace. Amen.

Thursday– Living God’s Story Together

Scripture: *“Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life, for those who are not holy will not see the Lord.”* — Hebrews 12:14

Reflection:

Faith is not meant to be lived in isolation. We are called into community—a family of believers who share stories, pursue unity, and bear witness to God’s love. The world knows Christ through the love and peace His people embody.

Application:

Share a part of your story with someone today. Encourage them by pointing to God’s work in your life.

Prayer:

Jesus, help me live in peace with others and walk in holiness. Use my story to bless and encourage those around me. Amen.

Friday – Keeping It R.E.A.L.

Scripture: *“May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me.”* — John 17:23

Reflection:

Jesus prayed for His followers to reveal God’s love through unity. Authentic faith is lived out in truth and integrity. Vulnerable faith is lived out in prayer, repentance, and community. Together, we keep it R.E.A.L.—Rooted, Equipped, Active, Living.

Application:

Review the week’s devotionals. Choose one area (Rooted, Equipped, Active, Living) where God is calling you deeper. Commit to one practical step this week.

Prayer:

Father, make me authentic before the world, vulnerable before You, generous in service, and united with my brothers and sisters. Let my life reveal Your love. Amen.
