MONDAY: The Gift We Don't Expect Scripture:

"God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance." — Romans 2:4

Reflection:

Question to Consider:

Scripture:

"Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." - Luke 9:23

Reflection:

In the Kingdom, surrender isn't losing – it's winning the life you were made for. When we hand over control, God fills our hands with better things than we could ever hold on our own. Surrender turns "I have to" into "I get to."

Question to Consider:

What's one thing you're still trying to control instead of giving to God?

Prayer:

Holy Spirit, renew my thoughts today. Replace fear with faith, lies with truth, and cynicism with hope.

THURSDAY: Renewal is God's Specialty

Scripture:

"If anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come..." -2 Corinthians 5:17

Reflection:

Repentance is never the end of the story – it's the beginning of something brand new. God doesn't just fix the broken parts; He transforms us from the inside out. Every time we turn back to Him, He breathes fresh life into us.

Question to Consider:

Where have you seen God bring new life after a season of turning back to Him?

Prayer:

Thank you, Lord, for making me new again and again. I receive Your fresh start today.

FRIDAY: Living in the Rhythm

Scripture:

"Repent ... so that times of refreshing may come from the Lord." — Acts 3:19

Reflection:

Repentance isn't a one-time event; it's the steady beat of Kingdom life. It keeps our hearts tune to God's song. Every time we return to Him, He restores our joy, deepens our faith, and keeps us dancing to His rhythm of grace.

Question to Consider:

How can you keep the rhythm of repentance alive in your daily walk?
