## 5-Day Devotional



### Monday: Love That Leads to Obedience

**Scripture:** John 14:15

**Reflection:**

Jesus connects love with obedience. To “keep” His commandments means to guard and treasure them as something precious. Obedience is not about duty—it is a reflection of how deeply we value Him.

When love is genuine, surrender becomes natural.

**Prayer:**

Lord, teach me to love You deeply so that I treasure and obey Your Word.

**Application:**

What command of Jesus can you intentionally guard and obey today?

### Tuesday: The Promise of an Advocate

**Scripture:** John 14:16; Hebrews 13:6

**Reflection:**

Jesus promised “another Helper”—the Holy Spirit—our Advocate, Comforter, and Encourager. He is not distant; He comes alongside us, strengthening us in moments of weakness and reminding us that we are never alone.

**Prayer:**

Holy Spirit, be my strength and encouragement today. Help me to rely on You.

**Application:**

In a moment of weakness today, pause and ask: *“Holy Spirit, help me.”*

## **Wednesday: His Indwelling Presence**

**Scripture:** John 14:17

**Reflection:**

God is not just with us—He is in us. Through the Holy Spirit, His presence dwells within us. This is the miracle of the New Covenant: we carry His presence into every space, every conversation, and every moment.

**Prayer:**

Lord, help me live with the awareness that You are within me.

**Application:**

Move through your day with a conscious awareness that God is present in you.

## **Thursday: God Makes His Home in You**

**Scripture:** John 14:23

**Reflection:**

Jesus reveals something deeply personal—God does not simply visit us; He makes His home in us. This speaks of relationship, nearness, and permanence. We are not temporary dwellings; we are chosen places of His abiding presence.

**Prayer:**

Father, thank You for making Your home in me. Help me create space in my heart for You.

**Application:**

What would it look like today to make your heart fully available to God?

## **Friday: The Gift of His Peace**

**Scripture:** John 14:27

**Reflection:**

Jesus gives a peace the world cannot offer. It is not dependent on circumstances but rooted in His presence. Even in uncertainty, His peace steadies our hearts and reminds us that He is in control.

**Prayer:**

Jesus, fill me with Your peace today. Quiet my heart and help me trust You fully.

**Application:**

When anxiety arises today, pause and receive His peace instead of reacting to the moment.
