



5-Day Devotional

Monday: Life from Chaos

Scripture: Genesis 1:2-3

God's Spirit was present at creation, bringing order and life out of darkness and chaos. The same Spirit is at work in your life today. No situation is too messy or broken for God to bring purpose and hope.

Reflect: Where do you need God's peace and direction right now?

Prayer: Holy Spirit, bring Your life and order into the areas of my life that feel chaotic. Help me trust You. Amen.

Tuesday: Empowered for Purpose

Scripture: Exodus 31:1-5

Throughout Scripture, God's Spirit empowered ordinary people to accomplish extraordinary things for His kingdom. God has given you gifts, talents, and opportunities to serve Him and others.

Reflect: How might God want to use your gifts this week?

Prayer: Lord, help me use the abilities You've given me to serve You faithfully. Amen.

Wednesday: Power to Be a Witness

Scripture: Acts 1:8

Jesus promised His followers power through the Holy Spirit so they could share the good news with the world. We are called to represent Jesus through both our words and our actions.

Reflect: Who in your life needs to experience the love of Christ?

Prayer: Holy Spirit, give me courage and wisdom to point others to Jesus. Amen.

Thursday: Choosing the Spirit

Scripture: Galatians 5:16-17

Every day we face a choice: follow our own desires or follow the leading of the Spirit. We cannot win this battle in our own strength, but God has given us His Spirit to help us walk in obedience.

Reflect: What area of your life do you need to surrender to God today?

Prayer: Father, help me rely on Your Spirit rather than my own strength. Amen.

Friday: Walking in Step

Scripture: Galatians 5:22-26; 2 Timothy 1:7

A life led by the Spirit produces spiritual fruit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. As we walk with God daily, He shapes us to become more like Jesus.

Reflect: Which fruit of the Spirit do you most need God to develop in you?

Prayer: Holy Spirit, help me walk in Your power, love, and self-control each day. Make me more like Jesus. Amen.
